

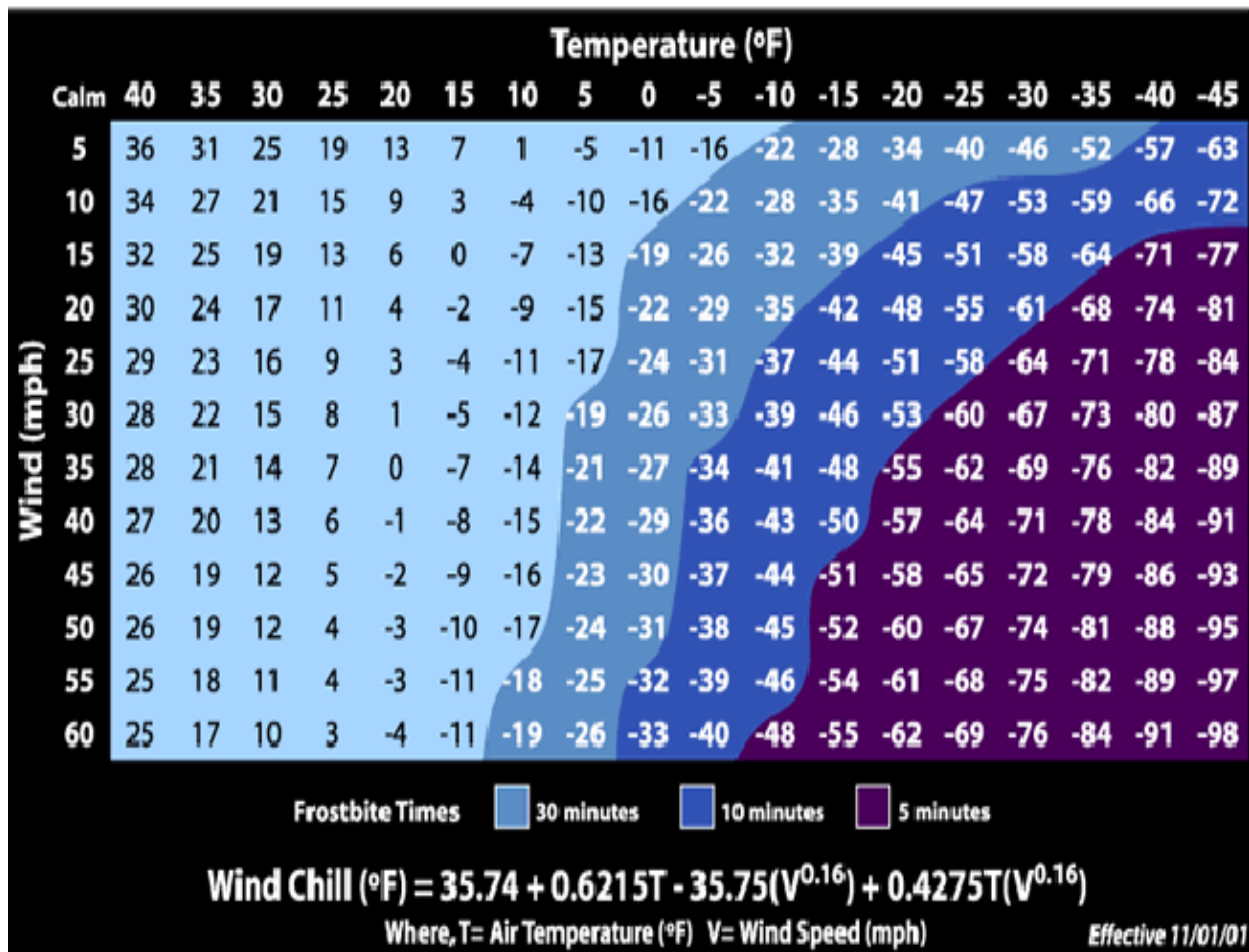

Cold Weather Warming Stations In The Columbus Area

Winter air temperatures in Columbus reached a new record low of -11°F in February 2015. With a wind speed of 15 mph, -11°F would feel like -33°F (windchill temperature), and just 30 minutes outside could put you at risk for frostbite. In Columbus, Warming Stations generally activate when temperatures (actual or wind-chill) drop below 25°F, offering vital respite from the cold for people who are experiencing homelessness. For most people, hypothermia can set in if their core body temperature drops to 95°F. The National Coalition for the Homeless estimates 700 hundred people experiencing or at risk of homelessness are killed from hypothermia annually in the United States. This map and accompanying service information show 34 Warming Stations supporting the community in the Columbus area this winter.
